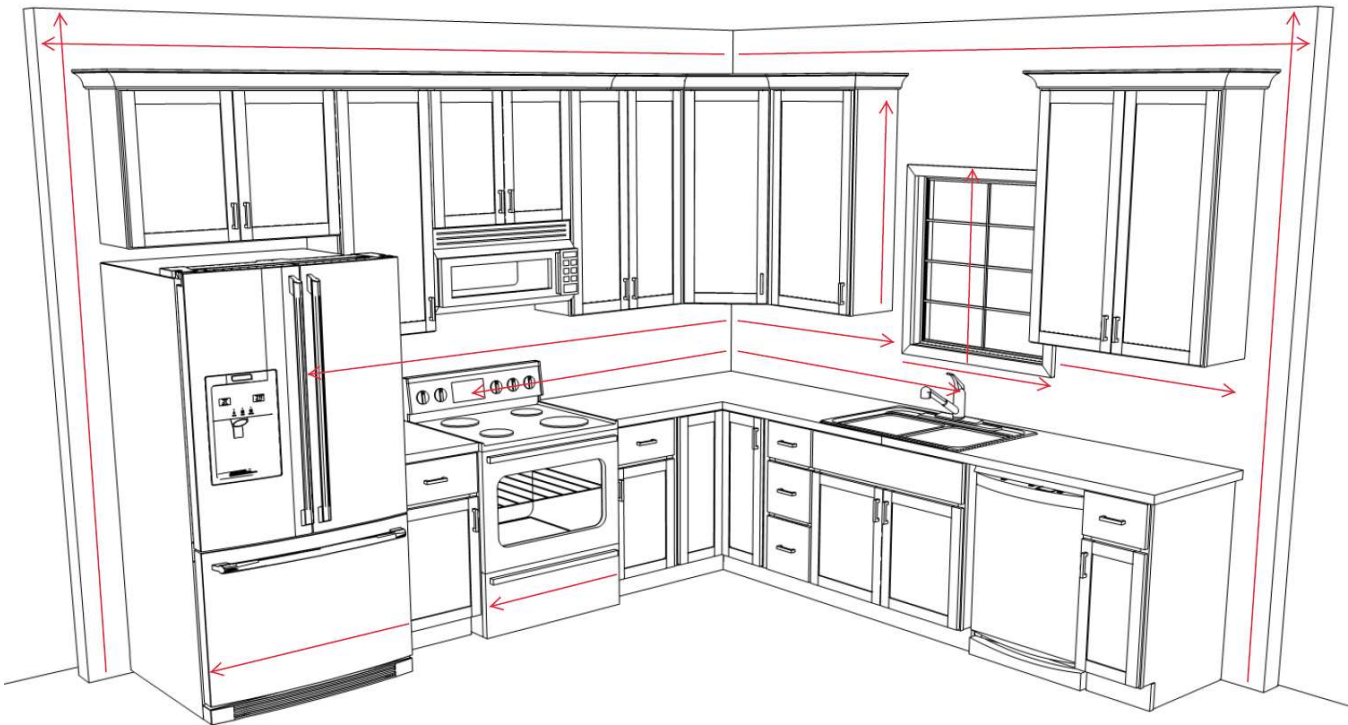




How to Measure for Cabinets

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How to Measure for a Kitchen Remodel or New Design:

- 1) Measure total wall length. Start in the corner to the end wall and/or doorway opening/trim.
- 2) Notate if total wall length is from stud to stud or included drywall.
- 3) Measure floor to ceiling (Measure in 2 to 3 different areas).
- 4) Measure distance from corner to start & finish of window (Include window trim molding in the width of the window measurement)
- 5) Measure distance from corner to center of any gas lines, water lines or electrical.
- 6) Notate if the microwave is vented to outside or recirculating.
- 7) Give all measurements of appliances, including width, height, and depth.
